Preference will be given to homes where constant adult supervision is available. Some rescue dogs may require special care (recovering from abuse, neglect, starvation, abandonment, illness). Persons interested in fostering a rescue dog should be familiar with dog behavior, have a fenced place for the dog to eliminate, and an area of the home where the dog can be safely confined.
